

RULES AND REGULATIONS

For the safety and consideration of everyone at Bow RiversEdge Campground, we ask that you please read and abide by the following:

The speed limit in the park is 10 km/hour and is strictly enforced. Please obey all directional signs and One Way street in the park.

Pets must be on a leash at all times, cleaned up after, and never left unattended. Please keep pets off the graveled playground area. There is an off-leash area located outside the gates along the Bow River. Charges for dogs are \$1/day/dog. Maximum of 2 dogs per site. Pets are not permitted in facility buildings.

Quiet hours are from 11 pm to 7 am. Playground must be vacated by 10 pm. Parents are responsible for the care and conduct of their children and pets at all times.

Fires are limited to the fire pits at your site and must be extinguished by midnight as per town of Cochrane bylaw. Only clean dry wood is permitted to be burned and may be purchased at the office.

All garbage must be contained in a garbage bag & placed in the garbage bin. Please respect the cleanliness of the campground. Do not use the fire pit as a garbage receptacle. Recycling must go into the recycle bin. We are an environmentally conscious facility and strive for minimal waste. Beverage containers must be separated and placed in the beverage recycling bins.

Proper sewer fittings are mandatory for your sewer hook up and can be purchased at the campground office. Do not dispose of black or grey water onto the ground.

Check out time is 11 am. There is not an option for a late check out. A late check out may be available upon request for a fee for extenuating circumstances pending availability. Check in is at 1pm. Guests will not be permitted access to their site prior to this time.

RV/vehicle washing is strictly prohibited anywhere in the park as per town of Cochrane bylaw.

The use of tarps is prohibited in the campground. Please do not use trees or power boxes to tie ropes or clotheslines to.

Gates close at 11 pm and re-open at 5 am. Vehicles can be parked in the parking lot next door until morning. Anyone found entering the park via vehicle after 11 pm may be subject to a nuisance fee. Please be courteous and respect the quiet time regulation for the benefit of all guests. All visitors must exit the park before 11pm. There are ground sensors by the garbage bin area. Gates will open automatically for exiting at anytime when closed. Re-entry is not permitted after 11pm.

Know your RV and your computer. Staff will not be responsible for connecting your computers to the internet, hooking up and or repairing your RV. Information is available at the office for mobile RV repair. The campground will not lend out tools or equipment.

All units must be self-contained. Freezers, refrigerators, and sheds are not permitted on sites. Cars, vans & converted school buses will not be permitted to register in the campground. RV units must be of acceptable optics, quality and year of manufacture, and are subject to management approval.

Any damages to the facilities will be the responsibility of the registered guest and charges will be made accordingly to the credit card on file. Unscheduled or extended stay overs may require a site move and are subject to availability.

Two vehicles per site are included in your rate. Extra vehicles and guests must be parked in designated guest parking areas and not in an empty site or the roadways. Please do not block or park in vacant sites. Anyone found parking a vehicle in a vacant site will be charged a fee and or be towed at the owner's expense.

Please keep RV mats off of the grass, damages done to the grassed area from an RV mat or pet will be charged a repair fee to the credit card on file. Generators are not to be use in the campground with the exception of a facility power failure. BBQ's and satellite dishes are not to be placed on picnic tables. Excessive noise will not be tolerated at any time.

Please do not have your mail forwarded to the campground. All mail not addressed to the campground will be returned to the sender. Please inquire in the office for alternative mail options.

Consumption of alcohol is restricted to your campsite. Odour from smoking materials as per campground respectful guidelines will be consumed in a manner as not to offend or deter from the enjoyment of the campground by other guests. Management will respond to all complaints in a timely and respectful manner.

Your rent is due and payable upon arrival. There is no option for a refund or rain check if your travel plans change. Guests must be 21 years of age or older to register. No third-party credit cards or cheques will be accepted. A valid credit card must be on file for all reservations. Bow RiversEdge campground does not accept responsibility or liability for personal injury or loss of personal property. All facilities are used at your own risk. Your registration acknowledges your receipt and agreement to our rules and regulations. Failure to comply with these regulations may result in additional fees. Management reserves the right to terminate your stay at any time for violations to our rules and regulations. Offenders will be asked to leave the premises in a timely manner.
